GOALS

LITERACY	ACT* scores will increase by 5% in each level and grade tested
MATH	Math ACT* scores will increase from 19.2 (2016) to 20.0 (2017)
ENGAGEMENT	The total number of students suspended at South will decrease by 5%
GRADUATION	South High School's graduation rate will increase by 5% from 2015-16

STRATEGIES

Programs for student growth and success:

- Math Center (individual math tutoring on site for all students at no cost)
- PLCs (Professional Learning Communities - Staff teams that work together to improve instruction)
- Co-Teaching (teachers working together in the same classroom to support students)
- SOEI (Standards of Effective Instruction – Staff evaluation system)
- AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination – academic support program for students)

Staff activities for student growth and success:

- Each teacher will complete a behavioral intervention plan, integrate student group work and teaming, and use frequent short and long assessments of various types.

Site activities for student growth and progress:

- Improve South's communication and community connections
- Promote equity in courses, teaching, and testing
- Create more classes that will reflect the school's diversity and students' interests

MEASUREMENT

- *ACT (American College Testing), the testing program used to measure student progress
- Quarterly review of student pass/fail rates
- Student/Parent survey
- CBMs (Curriculum-Based Measurements)
