ENGLISH

- 9th grade students will have 1 year-long English class which will be pre-assigned for you. All Nations and Liberal Arts students take Humanities. Open students take English 9.

SOCIAL STUDIES

- 9th grade students will have 1 year-long Social Studies class which will be pre-assigned for you. All Nations and Liberal Arts students take Humanities. Open students take World Studies.

MATH

- 9th grade students will be pre-assigned Intermediate Algebra. For advanced math students, we will receive an advanced placement list from the district with your recommended math level. On your form, please mark your correct math level. Talk to your current teacher for guidance on the right level. If you are a non-Minneapolis Public School student and advanced in math, please have your current math teacher email the recommended math level to, renee.magney@mpls.k12.mn.us.

SCIENCE

- 9th grade students take Physical Science which will be pre-assigned for you.

WORLD LANGUAGES

If you are beginning with level 1 of a language, please give us a 2nd choice as well. For students advanced in world language, we will receive an advanced placement list from the district with your recommended level. On your form, please mark your correct level. Talk to your current teacher for guidance on the right level. If you are a non-Minneapolis Public School student and advanced in a world language, please have your current world language teacher email the recommended level to, renee.magney@mpls.k12.mn.us.

ELECTIVES

Choose 8 from the following electives and number them in order of preference:

- Art
- Career & Technical Education
- Music
- Dance
- Theater
- Physical Education
- Health
- or other electives

MUSIC AUDITIONS

- Music auditions are required for certain classes. You must select the beginning level for now and adjustments may need to be made later.

- Refer to the South High Graduation Requirements for the appropriate level classes and/or sequence of classes you should be taking.
- The choices you are making are requests, not your actual scheduled classes.
- The schedule will be created before school starts in the fall.
- Every effort will be made to give you your preferred classes, but there are sometimes unavoidable conflicts.
- You need to be enrolled for a full year in core classes (English, Social Studies, Math & Science).
- 1 year of Fine Art, 1 semester of Fitness for Life (PE) and 1 semester of Health are required for graduation.
- 2 Semester classes = 1 full year.
- When numbering choices in order of preference: #1 is your 1st choice, #2 is your 2nd, etc.
- The AVID elective is a class that prepares students for college. An application and interview is required to take this class.
